Food


Leeds is known for its variety of restaurants, cafés and bars. The city's independent eateries are so prolific that they are celebrated by the annual Leeds Indie Food festival every spring. Quirky indie cafes are hidden around every corner, along with large food havens like Trinity Kitchen and Kirkgate Market (the largest covered market in Europe) which both host an array of ever-changing food vendors. If you fancy food with a view, there are rooftop spots like Belgrave Music Hall and Canteen, IF Rooftop or Sky Lounge. For international cuisines there's food from all over the world including French, Italian, Indian, Thai, and Vietnamese.



Shopping

Old meets new in Leeds' hugely walkable city centre. Beautiful arcades and Grade I-listed buildings sit side by side with modern shopping centres and contemporary architecture.

Iconic for its glass ceiling, Trinity Leeds features high street favourites, while the Corn Exchange has everything from vintage clothes and jewellery to arts, crafts and records. If you're a fan of high-end shopping, check out the stunning ornate arcades within Victoria Leeds, which are home to luxury boutiques and independent stores.

Typically lasting two years, these degrees allow you to complete your studies and begin your career quickly, graduating with a nationally recognised Level 5 qualification.

Top-up Degrees

Top-up Degrees act as a third year of study, lasting 12 months and are the same level as the third and final year of a full honours degree. They allow you to deepen your knowledge and skills in your chosen field, which can open up a wider range of career opportunities.

A Top-up Degree is ideal for students who have completed a relevant Foundation Degree or HND and wish to top up their qualification to gain a full honours degree.

Higher Technical Qualifications


Some of our Foundation Degrees have been approved against occupational standards in their sector as Higher Technical Oualifications (HTOs).

This'll mean working with farm animals first-hand and observing wildlife across a variety of sites within the Temple Newsam Estate. On the estate, you'll have access to one of Europe's largest Rare Breed Survival Trust (RBST) farms; home to Tamworth pigs, Kerry Hill sheep and Golden Guernsey goats, as well as domestic and exotic species at the animal care centre.

HOW TO APPLY

There are different application processes depending on whether you are applying for a full-time, part-time, apprenticeship or teacher training course.

Full-time applications

All full-time applicants for University Centre Leeds should apply online through UCAS. You can submit your application independently or via your school, college or education centre. You can find comprehensive information on the full application process at ucas.com.

Once you have registered and applied, you can keep track on your application status and offers in your UCAS Hub. UCAS also features support for Student Finance applications, as well as tips and advice about higher education.

These application processes ask for personal information, qualifications, work experience and references. We'll communicate with you via email to keep you updated on your application, including once you have applied, when we are processing your application, at the interview stage and once your application status has been decided.









FEES AND FUNDING

We understand there's become a greater focus on the cost of living for students and your families recently, and that funding your studies can be a daunting and challenging prospect. There is, however, plenty of financial help available to you, including sources of funding as well as financial support and advice.

Tuition fees

If you are eligible, you can apply for a tuition fee loan to cover the cost of your higher education from the government, which you repay gradually through pre-tax repayments once you earn a certain amount.

Tuition fees are mandatory and, depending on the course you choose to study, would cover course costs for aspects such as seminars and tutorials, visiting speakers and guest lecturers, learning facilities, equipment loans, course administration and assessment, support and wellbeing services, and more. The loans are available regardless of household income and are paid to us by the Student Loans Company.

Maintenance loans

Whether you plan to live at home or in student accommodation, you'll be able to apply for a maintenance loan from Student Finance to contribute towards your living costs such as rent, food and bills. The amount you'll receive will depend on household income and where you live.

Disabled Students' Allowance (DSA)

This provides extra financial help to UK higher education students. This is to meet any extra study costs, which may arise from a learning difficulty, disability and/or ongoing health condition. It is a non-repayable grant based on need, rather than income.

You can apply via your Student Finance account.

Bursaries

We offer a number of bursaries of up to £500 to support eligible full-time students during studies.

Additional funding

Other non-repayable support, such as Parents' Learning Allowance and childcare funding, is available.


