CONDITIONS

The Chromebook will not be issued to the student until the College has received the first instalment of the Student Loan or the first instalment of a direct debit.

If the student leaves the course before completion the student will return the Chromebook to the College.

There will be no replacement or repair to the Chromebook device by Leeds City College. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that the Chromebook is operational and fully charged at all times. The Chromebook has a 1 year warranty which must be registered and managed by the student.

It is the responsibility of the student to replace the Chromebook in the event of any theft of the device.

The Chromebook will be owned and managed by Leeds City College for access to software and Wi-Fi settings.

The Chromebook will be asset marked with Leeds City College branding. The Chromebook will be tracked through GPS to confirm its location if required in any theft or security incident.
